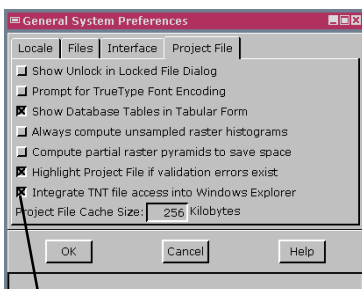


Click to Edit TNT Object

DID YOU KNOW ... you can click on a TNT spatial object to edit in the TNTproducts?

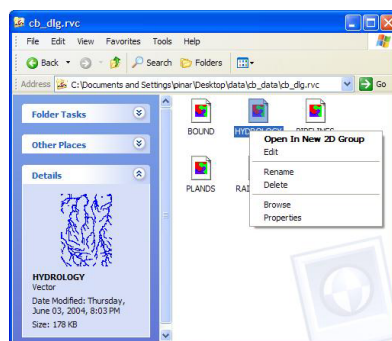
What Clicking to Edit TNT Spatial Objects Gives You

- Use TNT Explorer to open any TNT object for editing
- Automatic view of a TNT object in the Editor
- Rapid display of a TNT object for editing

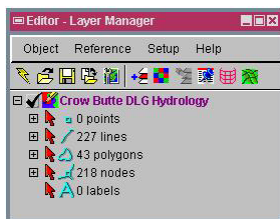


Edit contents of a Project File when TNT Explorer is enabled.

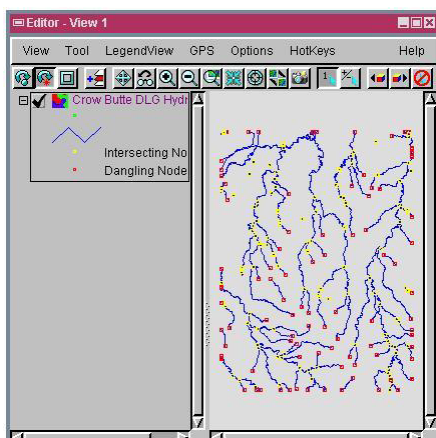
Right-click on the object you want to edit in the TNT products and select Edit from the menu.



Editing Project File contents is supported if running Windows XP with Service Pack 1 or newer Windows operating system.



After right-clicking on the object you want to display and selecting Edit from the menu, the Editor opens displaying the object selected.



How to Click to Edit TNT Spatial Objects

- Choose Tools/System/Preferences and click on Project File tab.
- Turn Integrate TNT file access into Windows Explorer toggle on.
- Navigate into your TNT data directory and browse into a Project File.
- Select a TNT object and right click on it.
- Select Edit from the menu that opens.
