What Turning Locator On/Off in Legend Gives You

- Choose to show the Locator in the Legend
- Choose to hide the Locator in the Legend

How to Turn On/Off Locator in Legend

- Display any group or layout in the Display or the Editor process.
- Open the Options menu in the View window and make sure the Show Legend button is toggled on.
- Toggle on Show Locator button on the Options menu to show the Locator.
- Toggle off Show Locator button on the Options menu to hide the Locator.
