Please get used to the idea of electronic software delivery. At the moment you receive only a CD when you purchase most software (e.g., Microsoft Office, Vista, Mac OS X, ...). Soon even this media will disappear from software distribution, whether it is the Google model of renting network-centric software or you purchase an authorization code (e.g., MI/X).

Reality. The CD version of the TNT products is simply the reproduction of the patched versions posted on a specific Wednesday for your downloading. No more, no less! Thus it will be **out of date** by the time you receive it.

Delivering your TNTmips, TNTedit, and TNTview on CD obeys the “law of the minimum.” The CD cannot be reproduced until everything is as ready as is practical: software, Technical Guides, Tutorials, and sample data. The software features for the release must be available before these supporting materials can be completed. Next it takes two or more weeks to have the CDs reproduced. Packing, shipping, customs, and delivery add two more weeks. Are you willing to wait several months to gain access to the new features that are of particular interest and value to your project?

It is a fast Internet dominated world! Keeping up in this world challenges you every day with new geospatial opportunities and corresponding issues.

Can I use my geodata in Google Earth or can I view and use sources of geodata published using open standards?

Can I create, use, and manage a large collection of geotagged digital photos with my map and image datasets?

How do I efficiently manage and view a large collection of small orthoimages (e.g., DOQQs or maps) or a smaller collection of large orthoimages (e.g., all the counties or provinces for a state or nation)?

You can address these and other challenges now by downloading and using version 2007:73 of your TNT product. And, as usual, in several months even more advanced capabilities will be added to your tool kit if you are willing to work with MicroImages to design, try, and perfect them in the development version 2008:74 of your TNT product.
