The 2014 Editions of TNTmips, TNTedit, and TNTview were released on 15 January 2014, bringing you over 400 new software features, over half of which were requested by our clients. It's not too late to order your upgrade to TNT 2014. Here are some of the highlights:

Highlight Features in the 2014 TNT Products

Redesigned and streamlined Mask Editor, Geospatial Catalog Manager, Style Editors, Style Assignment dialog, Layout Settings dialog, and Print dialog.

Use global MapQuest map and image tilesets in addition to Bing Maps as public reference layers in any View.

Run TNT products in Mac OSX 10.9 Mavericks.

Import and export Microsoft Access ACCDB files and Excel XLSX files (Microsoft Office 2007 and 2010; requires OLE DB Provider installed with the free Microsoft Access 12 Database Engine).

Import, create, and edit EPANET pipe network vector objects and run EPANET hydraulic simulations within TNTmips.

Use active or selected elements for measurement, sketches, regions, and generating profiles.

View histograms, apply contrast, and match contrast for color-composite images.

Vary the transparency of any raster or geometric layer in a view using a slider in the View window sidebar.

Populate fields in a database table using values from fields in a related table or with fixed values.

Search both local geocatalogs and the MicroImages online webmap catalog when selecting objects for display or other operations.

Display, import, and export many new file formats including ESRI File GeoDatabase and GeoRSS.

Create Open Layers geomashups using geometric web tilesets (SVG and KML) with legends, custom sidebars, and drawing/measurement tools.
