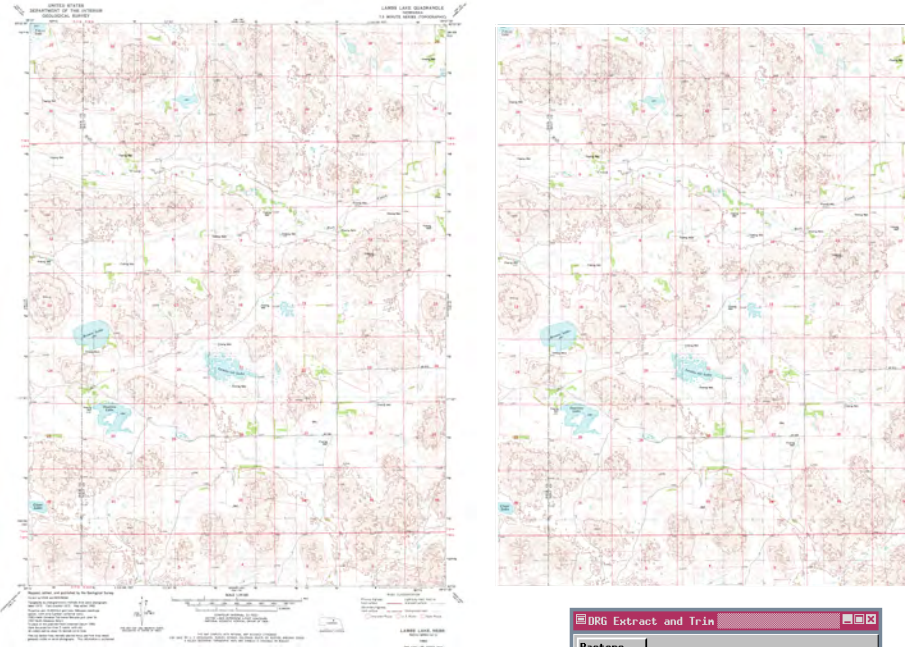


Extract and Trim DRGs

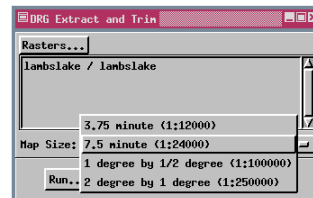
DID YOU KNOW . . . you can select a DRG directly in its TIFF format and automatically extract it to trim off the collar information?

What Extract and Trim DRGs Gives You

- First acquire your Digital Raster Graphics (DRG) files from USGS
- Removes collar information
- No need to import—just select the DRG TIFF file directly
- Select multiple DRGs at the same scale for processing
- Choose from DRGs at four different map scales
- DRGs in RVC format ready to mosaic or display with others



If you want to display or mosaic adjoining DRGs (Digital Raster Graphics files), you do not want the collar information. Here just one DRG is selected, but you can select as many as you like.



How Use Extract and Trim DRGs

- Choose Process/Raster/Utilities/Extract and Trim DRGs.
- Click on the Rasters button and select your DRGs.
- Set the map scale.
- Click on Run and name the output raster.
