


# DataTip Viewing Modes

**DID YOU KNOW** ... you can choose how layers contribute to DataTips?

## What DataTip Viewing Modes Give You


- Choose whether to show the DataTips for all, visible, or active layers
- Ability to access data from layers hidden in the current view
- A wider range of DataTip viewing scales for layers that turn on and/or off by scale
- Choose not to show any DataTips



This option turns off DataTip display.

The "Maximum" option allows you to view DataTips from all layers. The DataTip is limited to a maximum of 20 lines or a few more if the 20th line begins a multi-line DataTip.

The "Active/Top Layer" option lets you view DataTips only for the active layer. The DataTip is accessible even if the active layer is hidden in the current view.



The "Automatic by Scale" option turns off DataTips for map scale controlled layers unless the current scale is close to or in the visible scale range (zoomed in 100X past minimum scale or zoomed out more than 10X beyond maximum scale). For example, the contour elevation layer above is set to display between 1:100,000 and 1:2,500,000 and will contribute to the DataTip at scales between 1:1000 and 1:25,000,000.

## How to Change DataTip Viewing Modes

- Set the content of the DataTips for layers through Layer Controls window.
- Choose Options/DataTips in the View window.
- Choose one of the DataTip viewing modes from the DataTips option cascade.
