


Database Memo Fields

DID YOU KNOW . . . you can use memo fields for long descriptions that expand the information in other fields or provide miscellaneous information that does not fit in any other field?

What Database Memo Fields Give You


- Store descriptive information as a separate field in tabular view
- Create a string field of nearly unlimited length (more than a megabyte of a text)
- View or edit the text in a separate window
- View the full content of a memo field in single record view



Tabular View




Double-clicking on a memo field opens the Memo window where you can view or edit the entire content of the memo field.



Single Record View shows the full content of memo fields with scrolling if necessary.

How to Create Database Memo Fields

- Create a new field in the database table.
- Select Memo from the Field Type menu.
- In tabular view, double-click on the memo field.
- Enter the desired text in the Memo window that opens.
