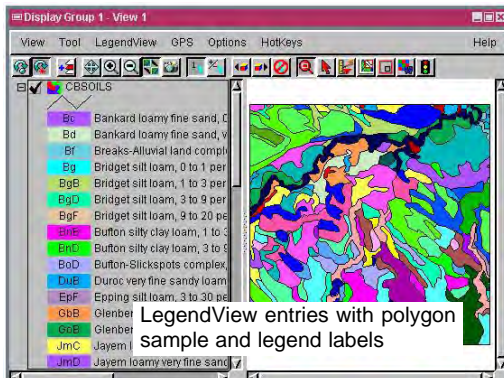
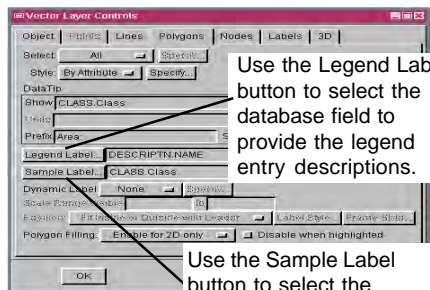


# Text Labels for Polygon Legends

**DID YOU KNOW . . .** you can create text labels in addition to sample polygon styles in polygon legends?

## What Text Labels for Polygon Legends Give You

- Enhance information content and appearance of legends
- Auto-generate corresponding labels for the polygon samples in legends
- Select any database field to use as text label



The LegendView of the vector object illustrated contains the descriptions and the symbols of the soil classes as the legend label and sample label, respectively.

Legend Label: DESCRIPTION.name

Bc	Bankard loamy fine sand, 0 to 2 percent slopes
Bd	Bankard loamy fine sand, wet variant, 0 to 2 percent slopes
Bf	Breaks-Alluvial land complex
Bg	Bridget silt loam, 0 to 1 percent slopes
BgB	Bridget silt loam, 1 to 3 percent slopes
BgD	Bridget silt loam, 3 to 9 percent slopes
BgF	Bridget silt loam, 9 to 20 percent slopes
BtE	Buften silty clay loam, 1 to 3 percent slopes
BtD	Buften silty clay loam, 3 to 9 percent slopes
BoD	Buften-Slickspots complex, 0 to 9 percent slopes
DuE	Duroc very fine sandy loam, 1 to 3 percent slopes
EpF	Epping silt loam, 3 to 30 percent slopes

## How to Create Text Labels for Polygon Legends

- Click on the vector icon to open the Vector Layer Controls window.
- Click on the Sample Label button on the Polygon tabbed panel.
- Select the database field to provide the sample label text.
- Click on the Legend Label button and repeat step3.
