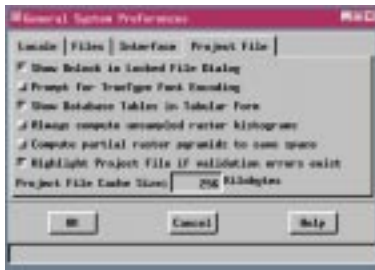


RVC Object Validation

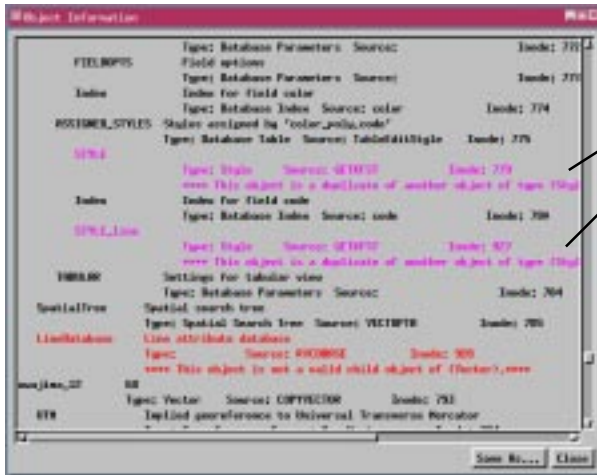
DID YOU KNOW . . . you can check your RVC files and objects for validity and conflicts?

What RVC Object Validation Gives You

- Red highlight for invalid objects in Project File Maintenance
- Magenta highlight for conflicting subobjects in Project File Maintenance
- Optional color-coded alert at the file level



If you turn on the highlight toggle, file names with validation problems will be color coded in Project File Maintenance (right).



Two style objects exist under the line style assignment table, and there only can be one. You need to pick the one you want to keep and use Project File Maintenance to delete the other.

Subobjects that are invalid or are in conflict (more than one exists and only one is allowed) are always color coded in the Object Information window whether the toggle is on or off.

RVC OBJECT VALIDATION

How to Use RVC Object Validation

- Choose Support/Setup/Preferences and turn on the "Highlight Project File if validation errors exist" toggle on the Project File tabbed panel if desired.
- Choose Support/Maintenance/Project File and click on the Info button.
- Click on the name of a file shown in red or magenta.
- Scroll through the Object Information and identify the problem objects.
- Resolve any conflicts and delete invalid objects.
