Another Large Project Completed Using TNTmips

TNTAtlas on CD, and TNTserver on the Internet

The Maryland Department of Natural Resources has used TNTmips to build a complete state-wide GIS system of about 100 detailed map themes and images (see list attached). This Maryland Environmental Resources and Land Information Network (MERLIN) now uses this geodata totaling hundred of gigabytes. These GIS materials are published internally via the Department network and for public access via the Internet using TNTserver. The same materials are distributed free in county units as TNTatlases on CDs.
