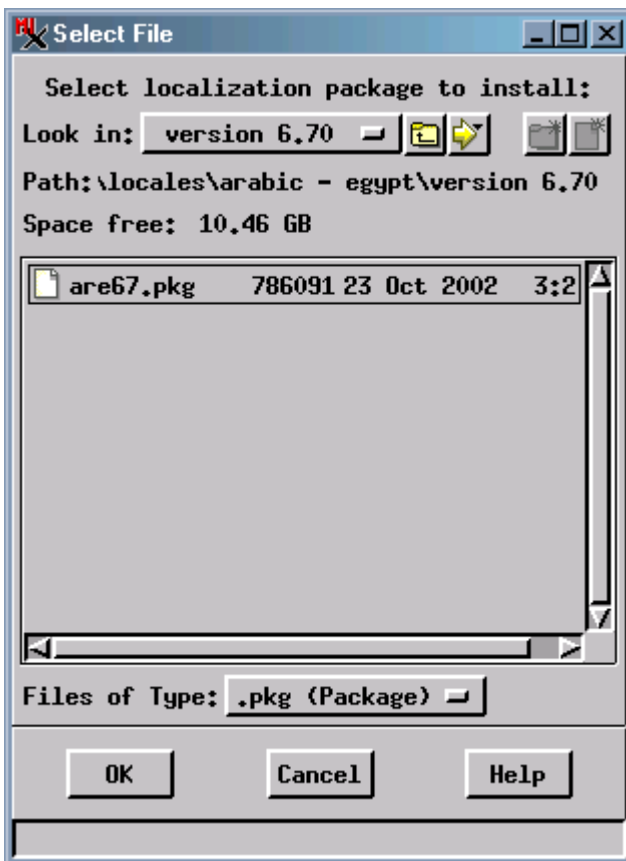
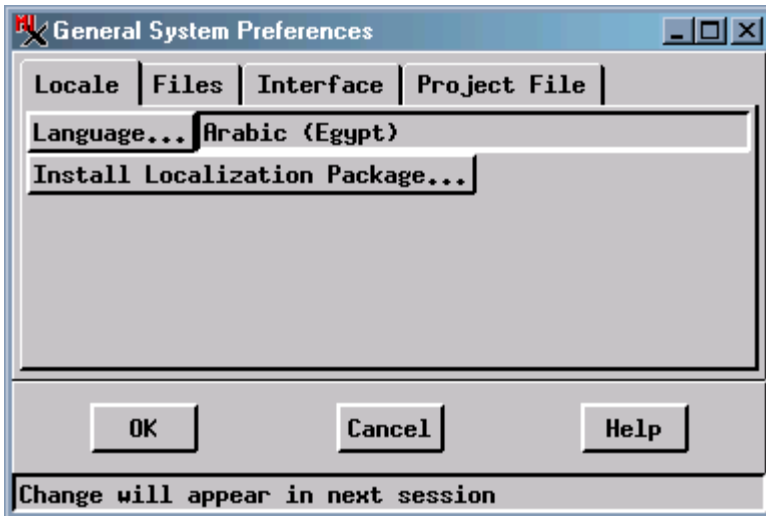


Using Arabic in the TNT products

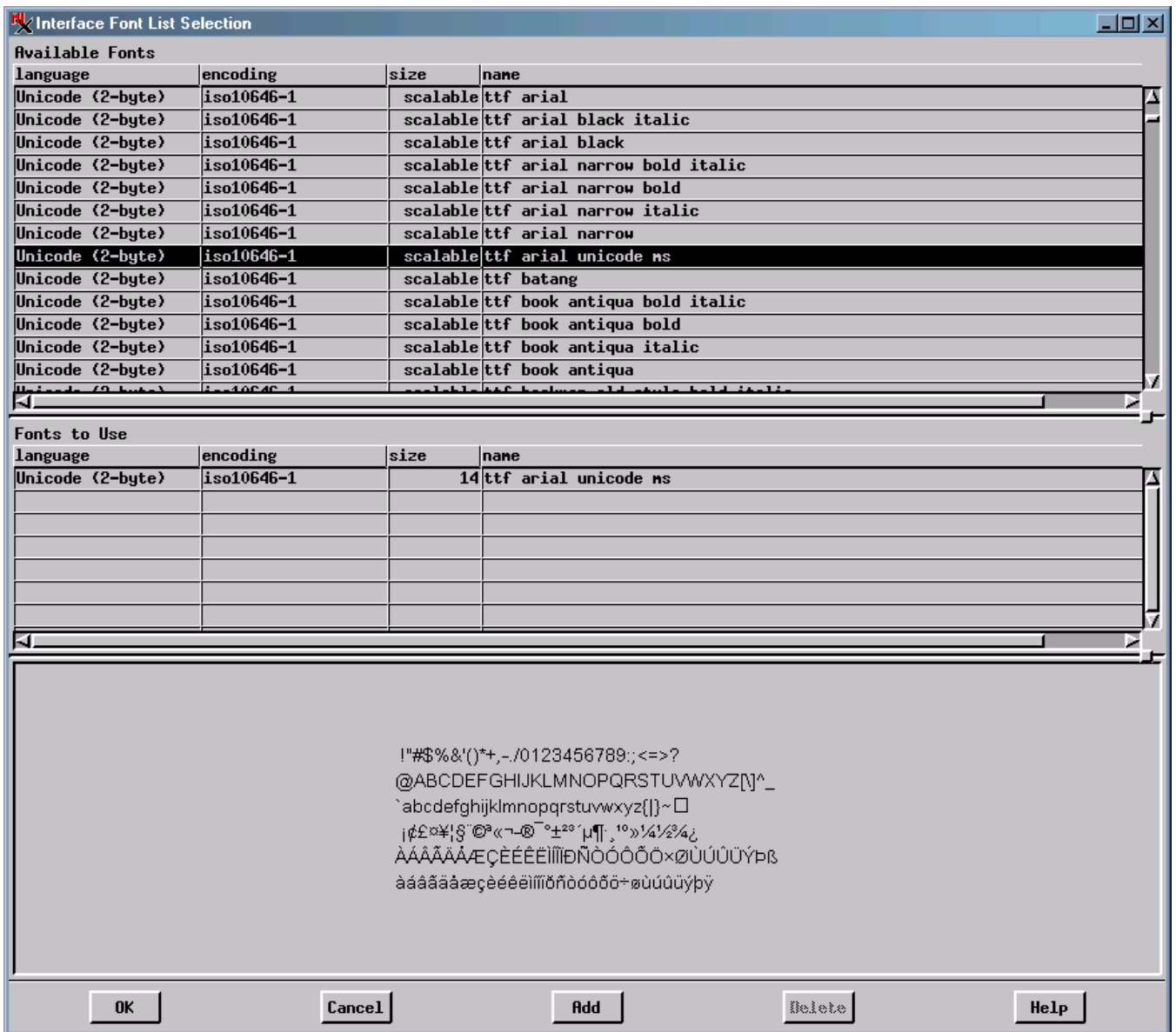
In order to fully use the Arabic support in the TNT products, you must be running either Windows 2000 or Windows XP as these Windows versions support Unicode. Other versions of Windows (95/98/NT/ME) do not fully support Arabic.

In order to use the Arabic user interface (are*.pkg) in the TNT products, it must be downloaded from MicroImages website at www.microimages.com/i18n/locales/ _____. After downloading and unzipping the Arabic interface package, it must be installed using Support / Setup / Preferences and clicking on Install Localization Package button on the Locale tabbed panel. The option to install interface package(s) is found under General Options of TNTedit and TNTview.

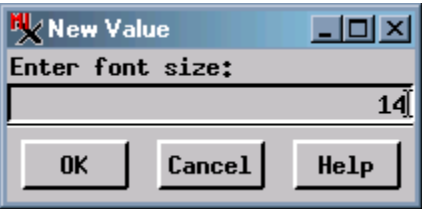




After installing the Arabic interface kit, you must change the font used for the user interface for the TNT products. This is done by using Support / Setup / Fonts. You will want to remove the fonts shown below under “Fonts to Use” by highlighting the name of the font in the selection list and pressing “delete” for each of the fonts listed. After all of the fonts have been deleted, you need to add an Arabic TrueType font. This is done by scrolling down the list of available fonts and selecting an Arabic font as installed in Windows 2000. It is suggested that either Arabic Transparent or Arial Unicode MS (provided with Office 2000) be used for the user interface. Each of these fonts has all of the Arabic glyph forms (characters / letters) for doing the correct auto shaping when used in the TNT products. In addition, the user interface appears much cleaner. Other TrueType fonts can be used, but either may not have all of the Arabic glyphs or do not join when displayed.



After selecting a font including the point size (14 point recommended), you will need to exit the TNT product and restart the software.



The user interface that is displayed will appear as:
